Graduate veterinarians must submit a copy of diploma that has been notarized with a statement that the notary public has seen the original document and verifies the duplicate to be an exact copy of the original. Graduate veterinarians may also send an official transcript showing graduation date or a letter from the Dean, with original signature, as verification.

If enrolled in, or a graduate of a foreign veterinary school, candidate must supply official verification of completion or current enrollment in the Educational Commission for Foreign Veterinary Graduates (ECFVG) program or the Program for the Assessment of Veterinary Education Equivalence (PAVE) program at the time of this application.

In agreement with the NBVME, a NAVLE candidate may not sit for the NAVLE more than five (5) times and may not sit for the examination at a date that is later than five (5) years after a candidate's initial attempt. Each of the final two attempts must be at least one year from the previous attempt.
