Graduate veterinarians must submit a copy of their diploma that has been notarized with a statement that the notary public has seen the original document and verifies the duplicate to be an exact copy of the original. Graduate veterinarians may also send an official transcript showing their graduation date or a letter from the Dean of the school attesting to candidate's graduation and degree with original signature in blue ink as verification.

If enrolled in, or a graduate of a foreign veterinary school not accredited by the AVMA, candidate must supply official verification of completion or of current enrollment in the Educational Commission for Foreign Veterinary Graduates (ECFVG) program or the Program for the Assessment of Veterinary Education Equivalence (PAVE) program with this application.

NAVLE testing window requested: November 14-December 10, 2011 April 9-21, 2012

In agreement with the NBVME, a NAVLE candidate may not sit for the NAVLE more than five (5) times and may not sit for the examination at a date that is later than five (5) years after a candidate's initial attempt. Each of the final two attempts must be at least one year from the previous attempt.
