VTNE

The VTNE (Veterinary Technician National Examination) is now applied for and administered through the American Association of Veterinary State Boards (www.aavsb.org) A passing score on this examination is a requirement for registration in West Virginia. State Boards of Veterinary Medicine are no longer administrators of the VTNE after January 2010.

If you apply for registration in WV, you must apply through the AAVSB's VTNE to have your scores forwarded to the WV Board of Veterinary Medicine. If you pass the WV written exam, we can not authorize your registration in WV unless and until we receive directly from the AAVSB written score reports ascertaining your passing score on the Veterinary Technician National Exam.

All questions regarding the VTNE are to be directed to the new administrators of the exam.
